Reason	While we do not have a definite answer, we did receive more requests for our interlibrary loan services from other libraries during this period. This could be due to more people being back using their library, but we are unable to verify.

Reason	This increase was attributed to more faculty and students back on campus and more research activity reassuming that needed us to borrow materials and documents from other libraries using interlibrary loan.
