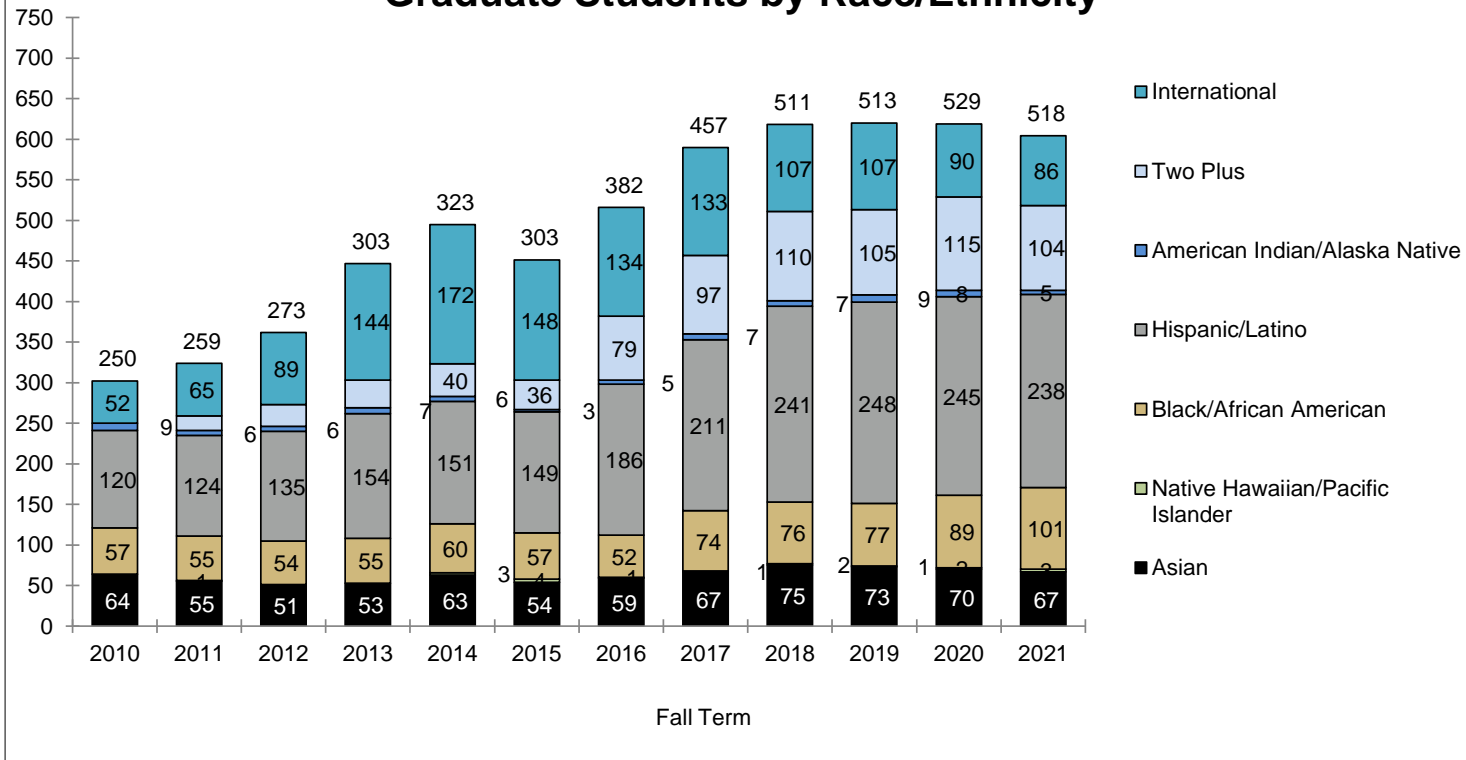

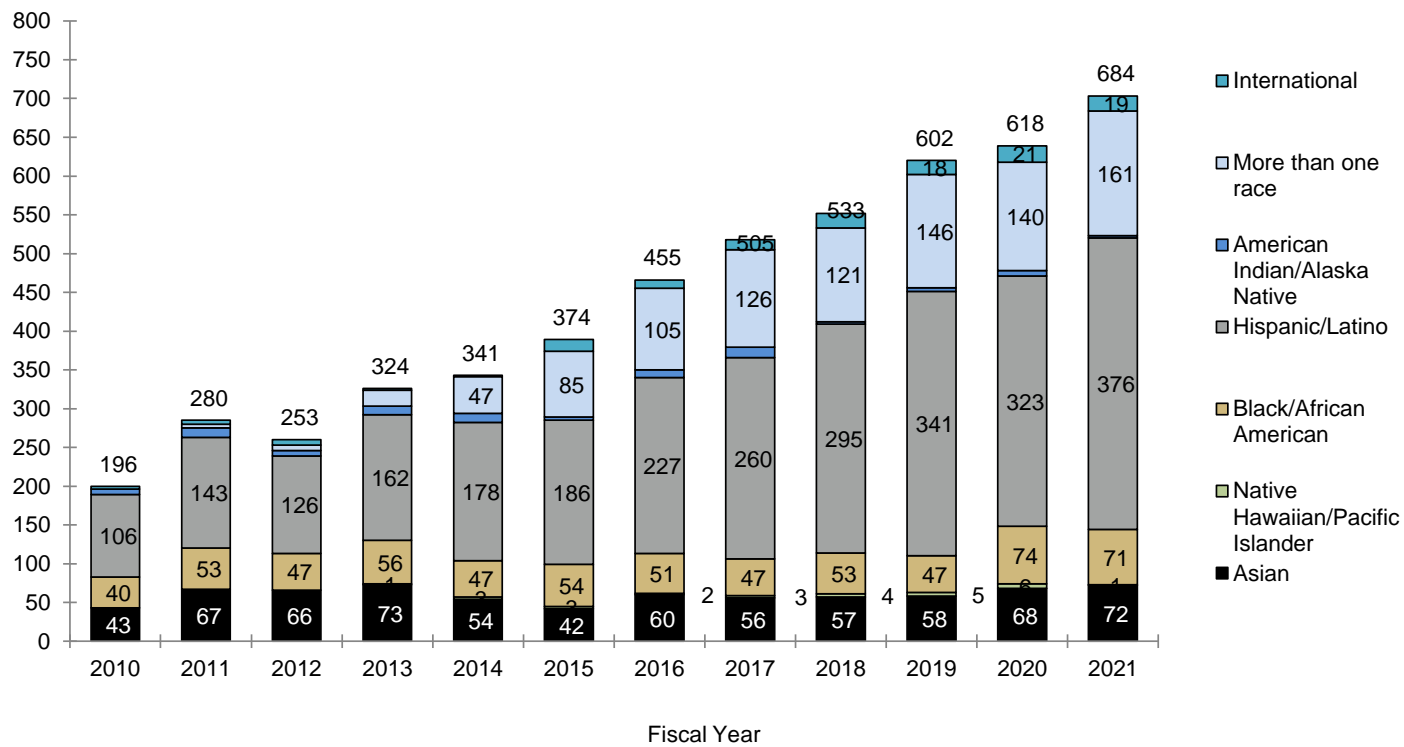

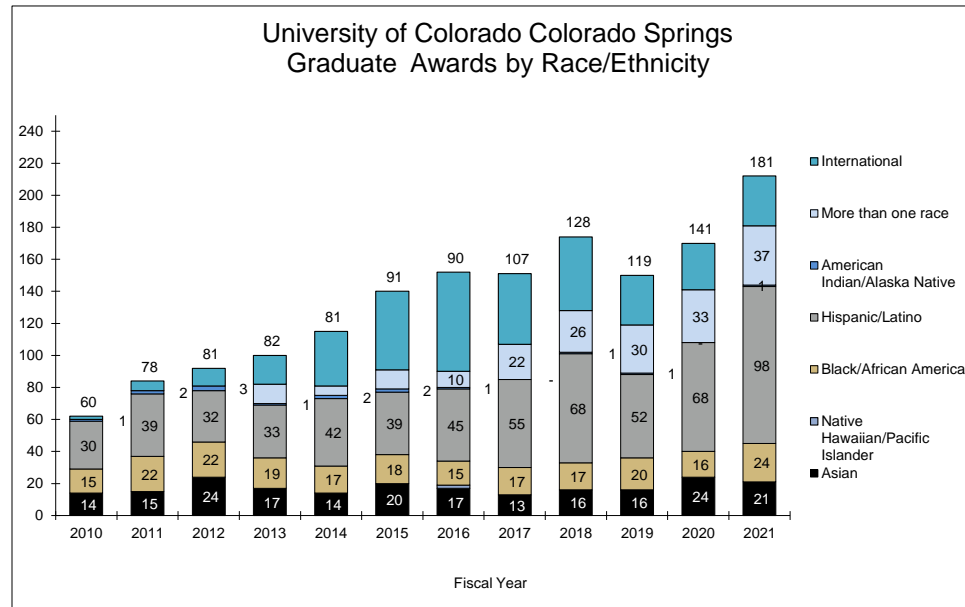

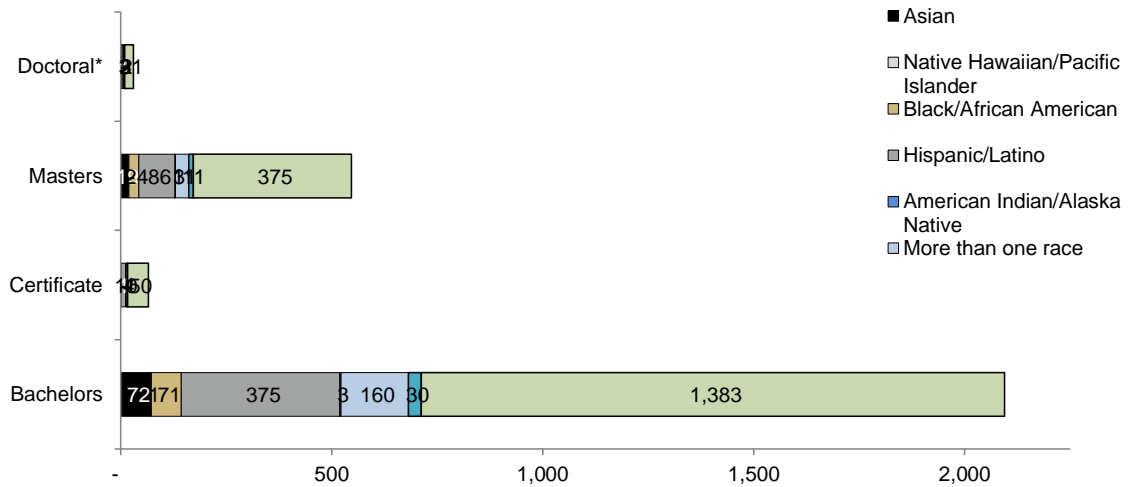

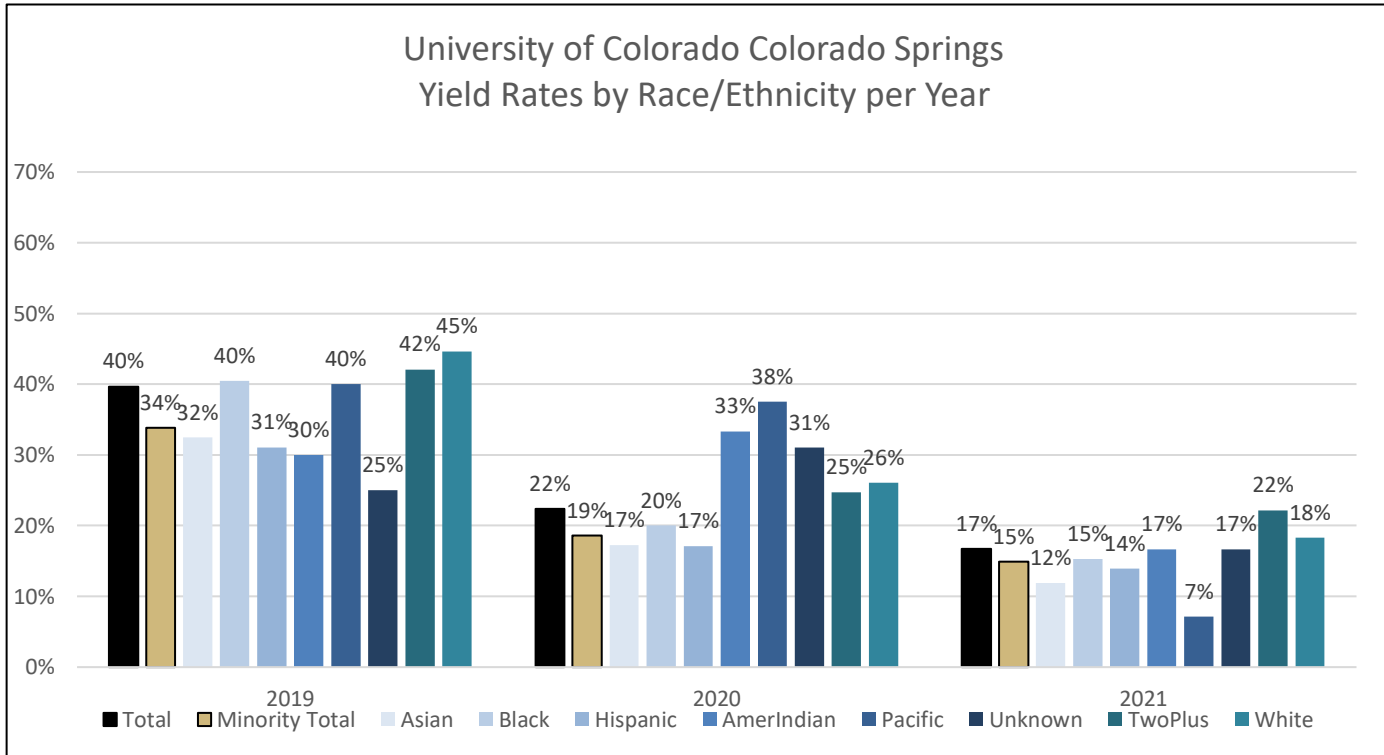

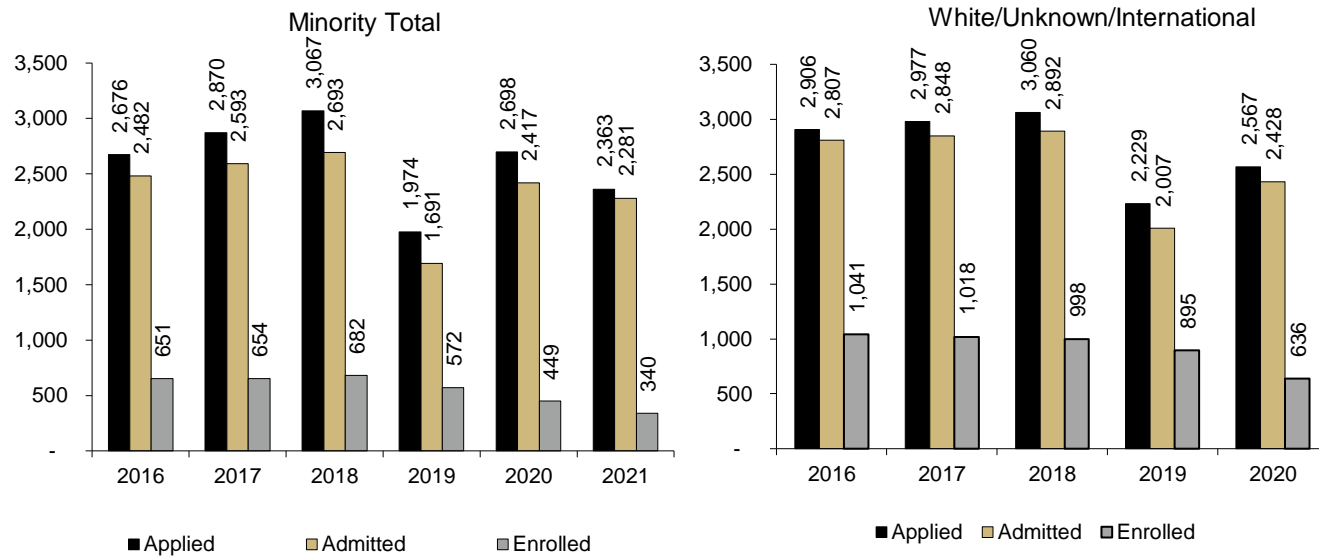

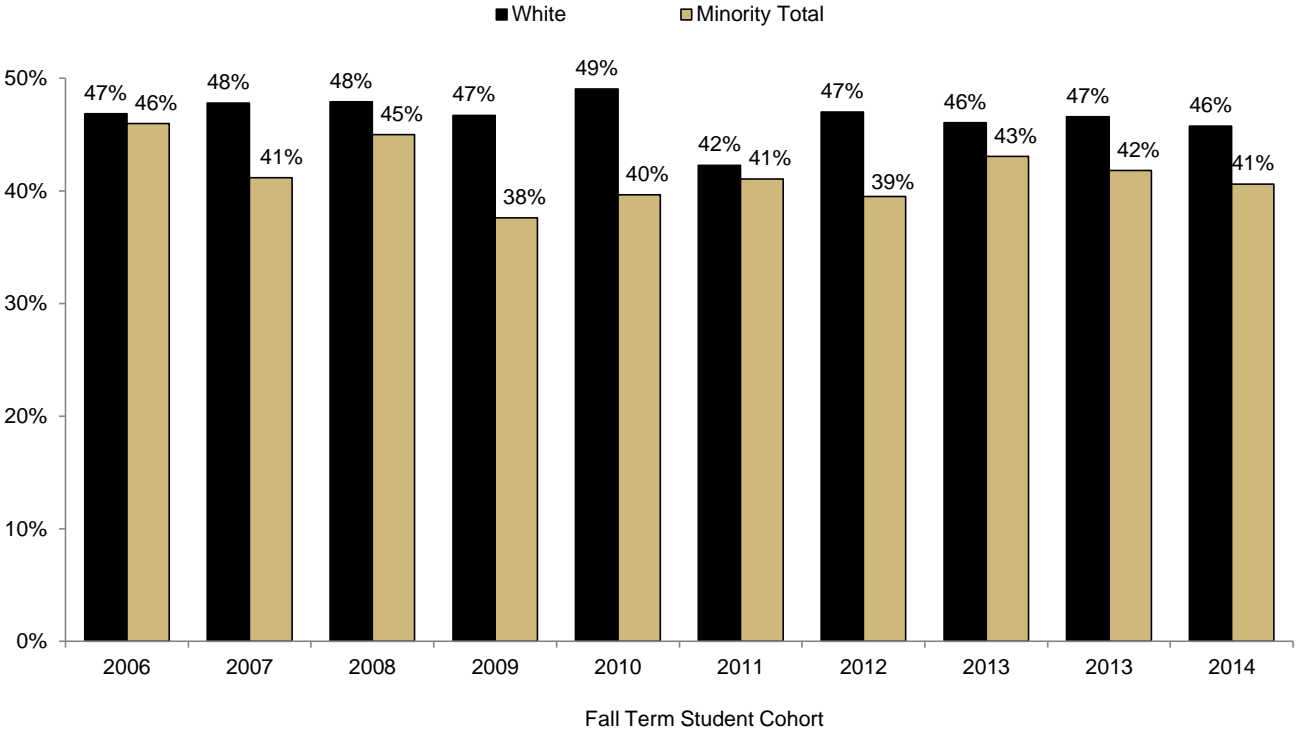

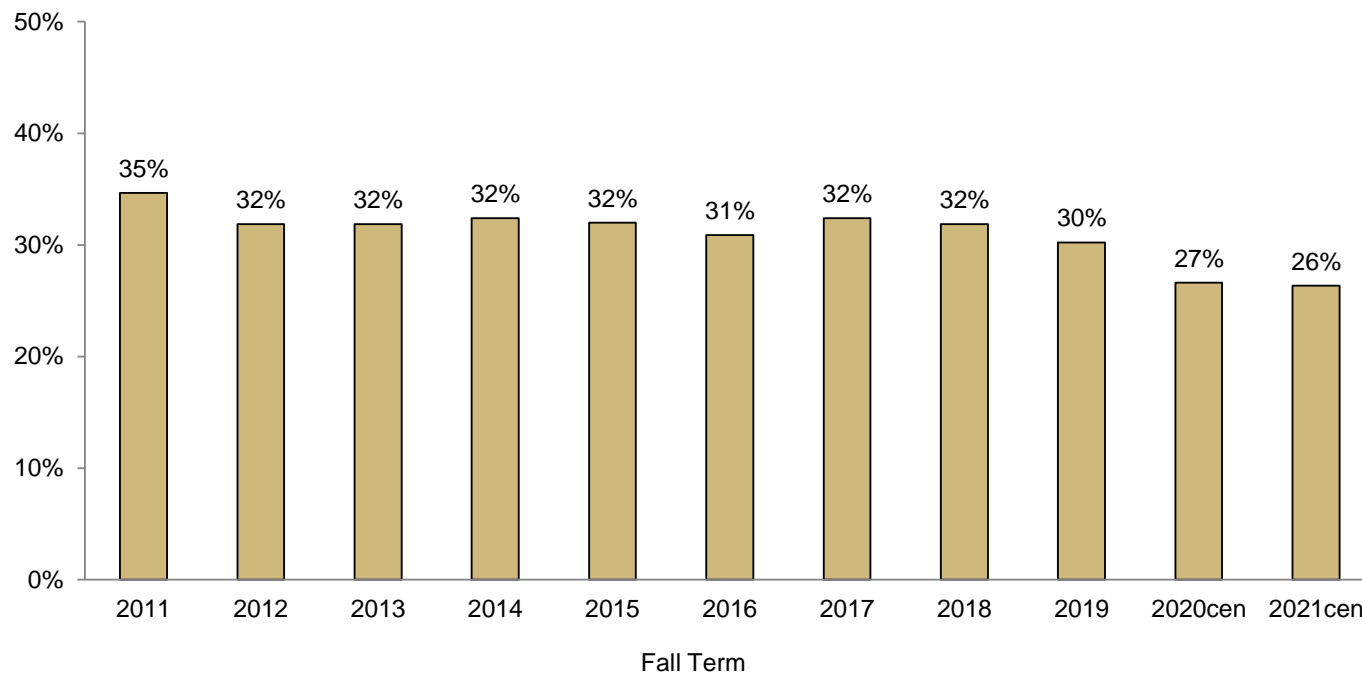

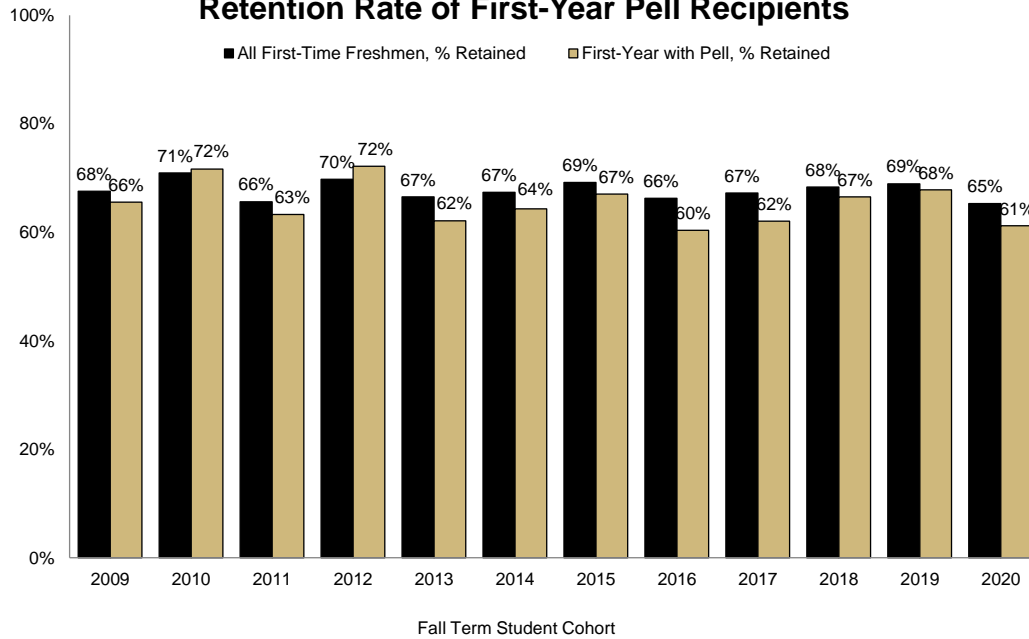

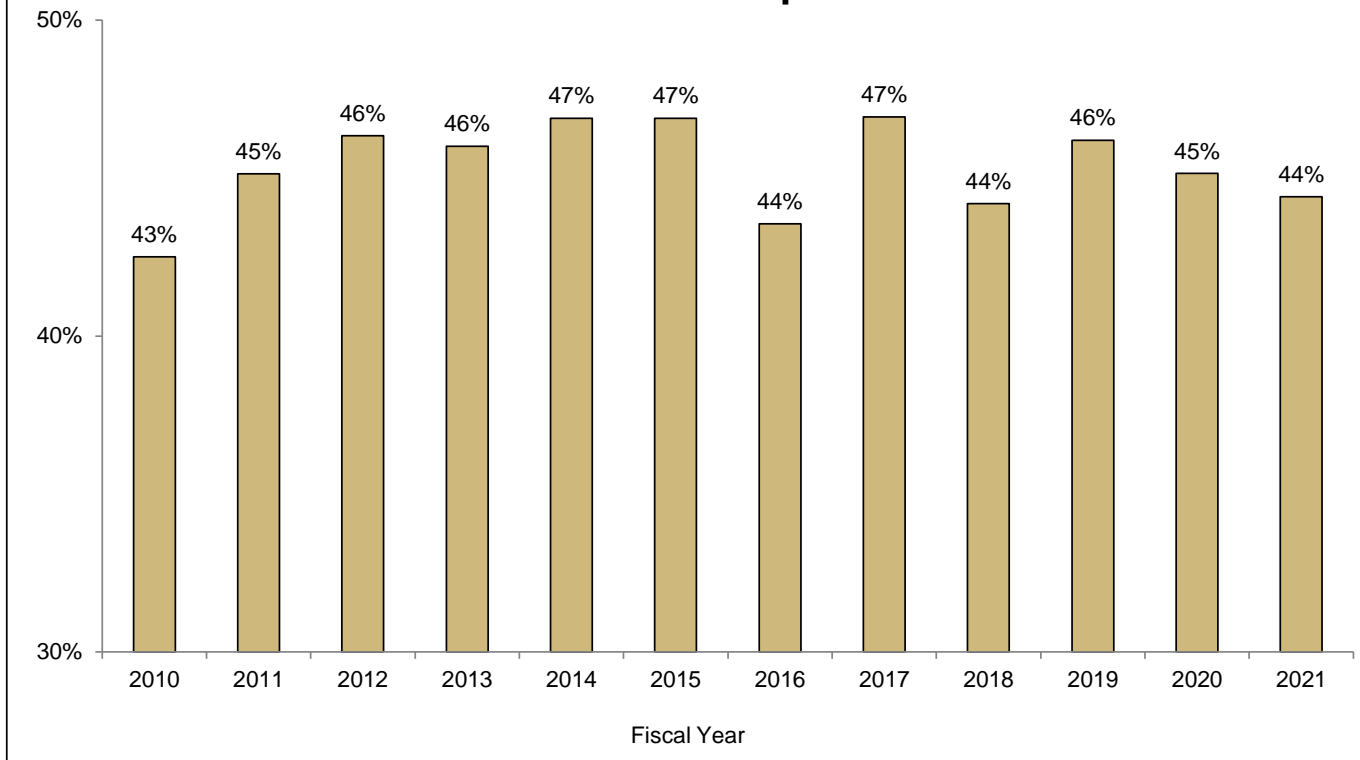

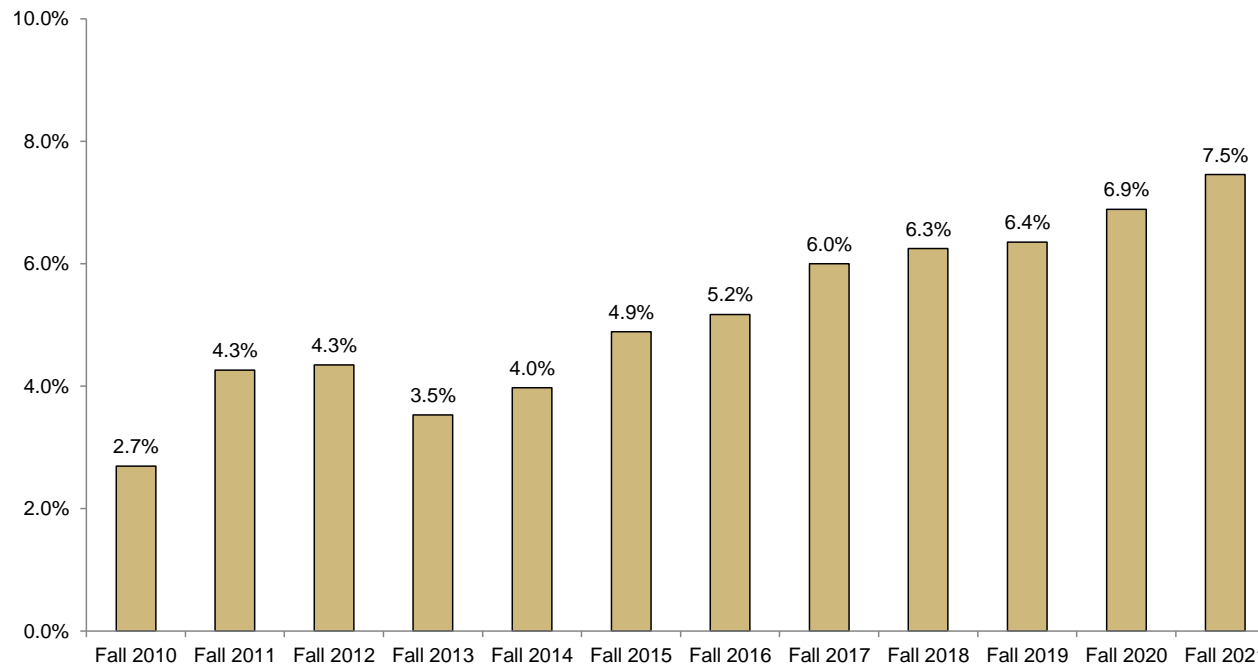

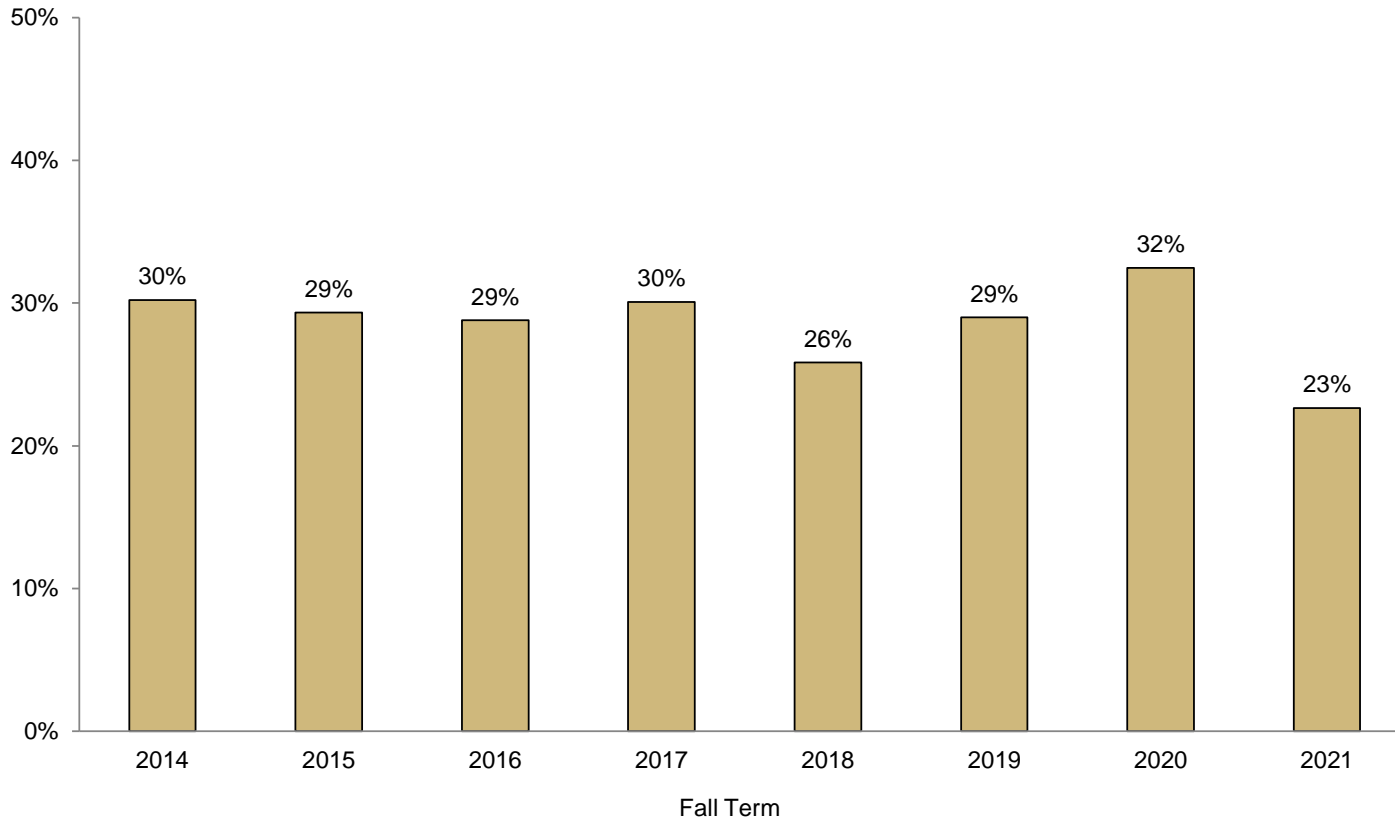

as a Percent of All Undergraduates



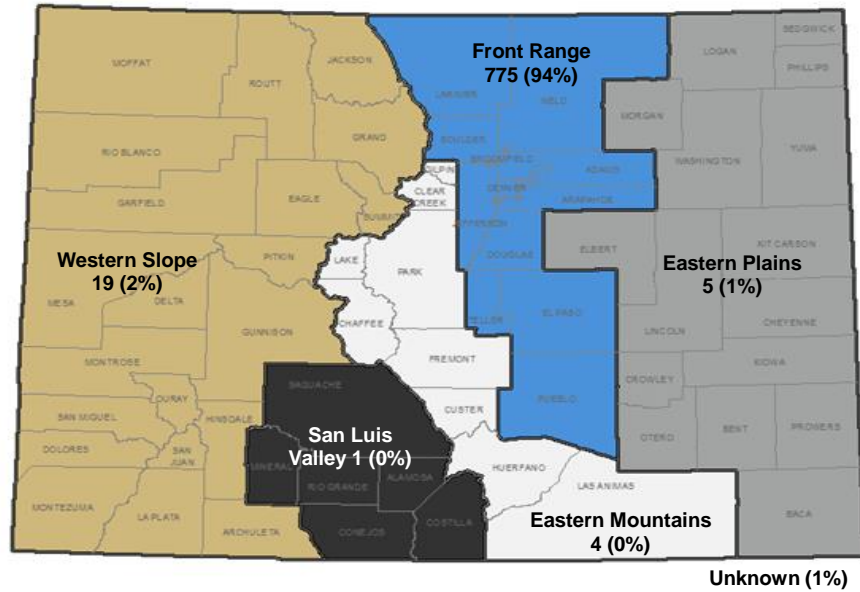

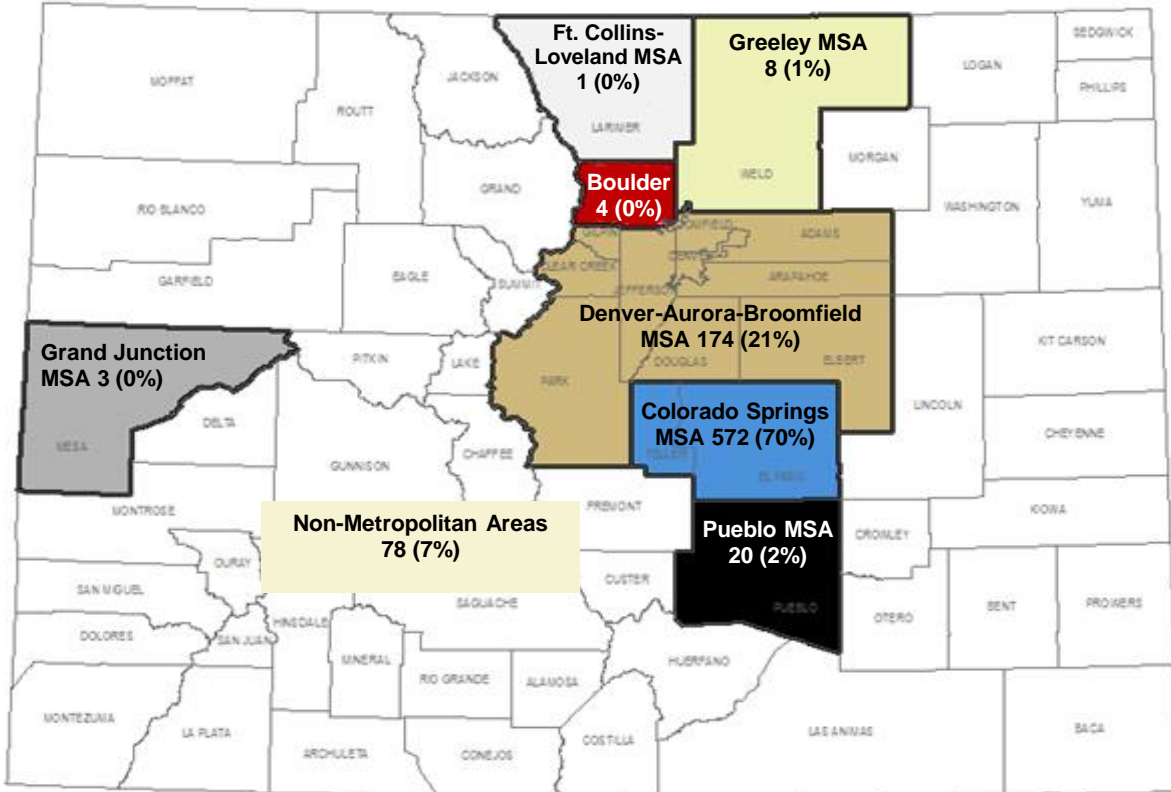

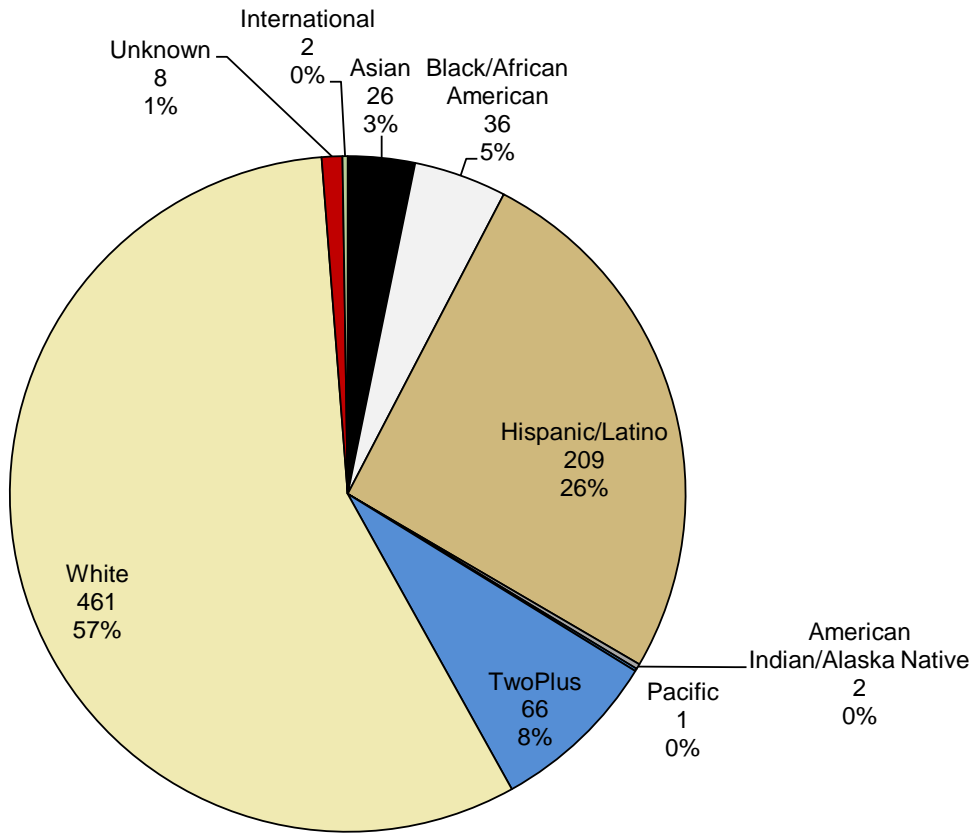

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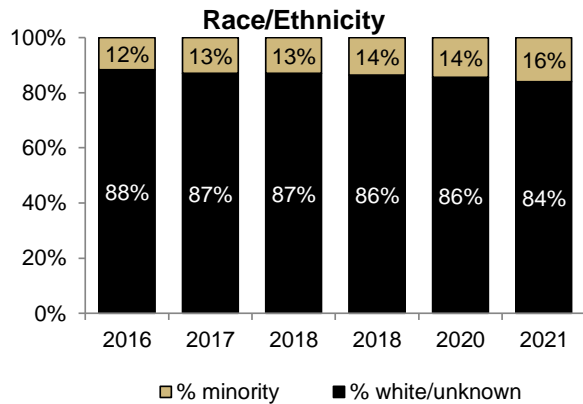
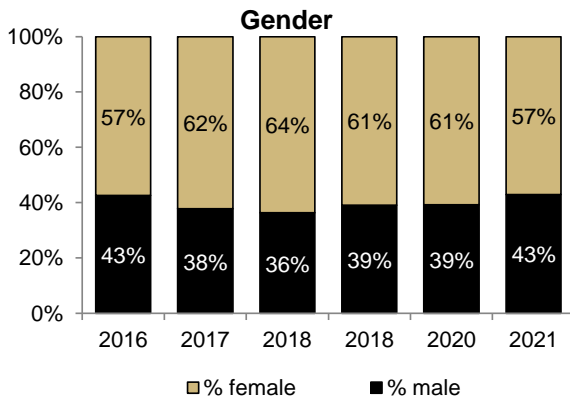
Instructional Faculty, Fall 2021 Tenured/Tenure Track

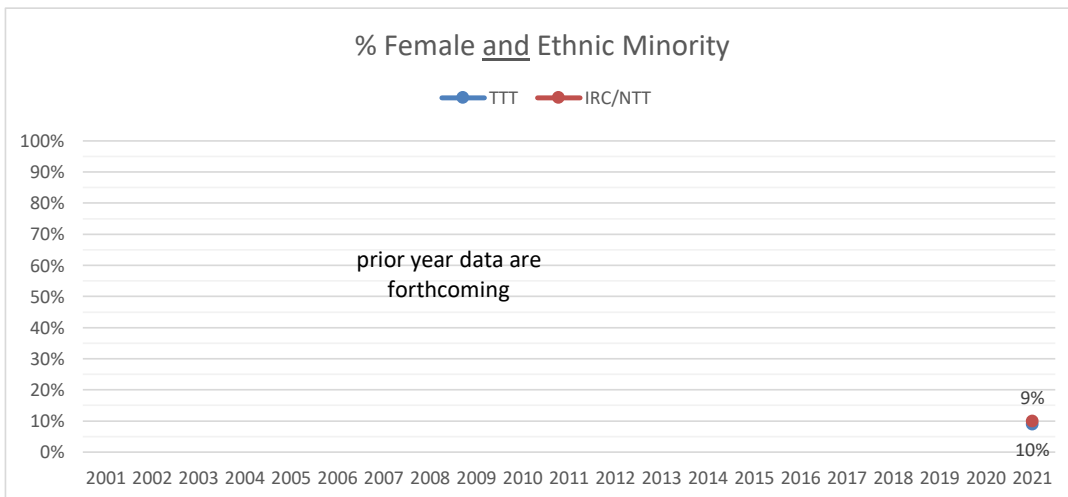
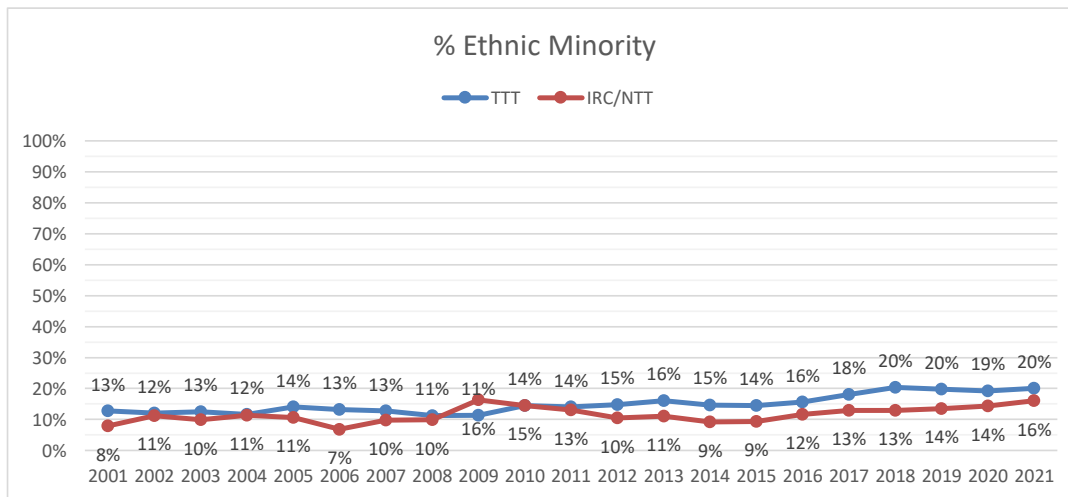
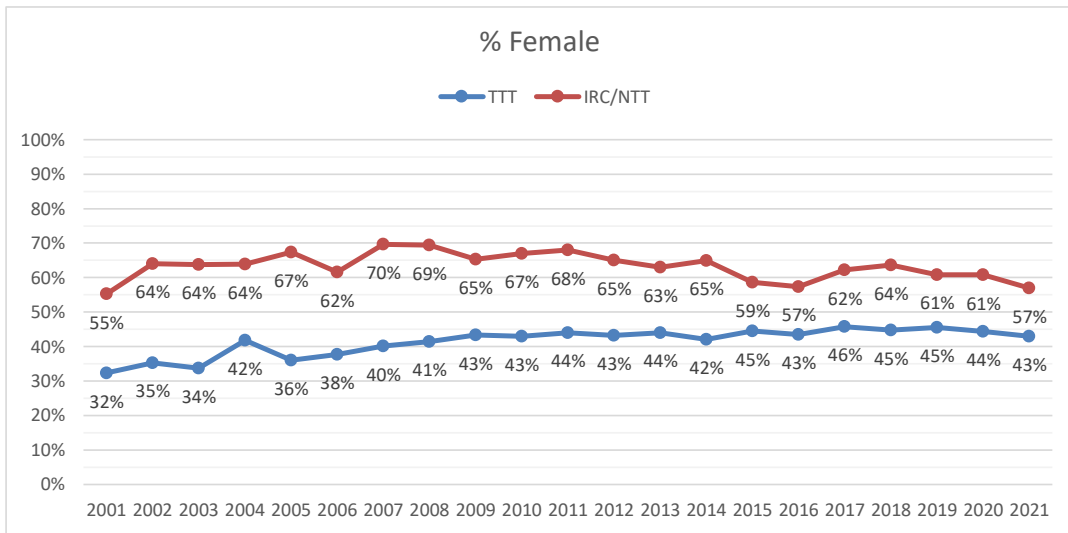


Instructional Faculty, Fall 2016 - Fall 2021 Tenured/Tenure Track Faculty
